Travelling to Kiev

You should organise your travel to arrive in Kiev according to the programme. As mentioned, the programme will start on **October 8th at 2 pm** and finish on **October 11th at 2 pm including lunch**.

The interdiac **Research Workshop** (October 11th -12th 2018) will follow the conference.

We recommend that you aim to arrive in time in order to be able to attend at all the conference sessions because the programme is designed as a continuous process.
